ORDER DEADLINE:

Orders are due by **July 15**th for delivery in Spring of the following year. Meristem plants are prepared by custom order beginning in August. Plants ordered after July 15th may not be available. Please let us know the approximate date you would like to receive your plants at the time of ordering.

LICENSE:

Buyer must be a licensed propagator of UC-patented strawberry cultivar(s). For licensing

inquiries contact Kendra Smith at Innovation Access. kosmith@.ucdavis.edu or 530-754-8713. Licensing with IA does not guarantee the availability of plants. Varieties off-patent in the U.S. may still have restrictions when distributed outside the U.S.

TERMS:

Allocation Policy

In the event that orders exceed supply, plants are allocated according to an established priority system among those whose orders are confirmed by the order due date. Orders are confirmed upon receipt of a signed order form. Any extra plants are sold on a first-come, first-served basis.

Order Pickup at the FPS facility:

Due to space and labor limitations, we request that plants be picked up within 2 weeks of the date that they are ready. FPS reserves the right to assess customers a fee for maintenance of plants that are not picked up after 2 weeks.

Packing and Shipping Fees

For orders that are shipped to customers, a packing fee of 10% is added for orders within the U.S.; a packing fee of 25% is added for orders outside the U.S. Shipping fees are charged at actual cost to FPS. Buyer assumes risk of loss during shipment. Additional fees may be added for documentation or testing required by destination.

Cancellations and Changes

Because FPS materials are custom prepared for each customer, cancellations are not accepted once plants have been started. Additions to orders will receive allocation priority according to the date they were added.

Foreign Orders

Shipments outside the U.S. will use an international express air courier, with the customer paying all fees. Letters of credit will not be accepted. Most foreign orders require an import permit from the destination country's national plant protection service in order to obtain the required phytosanitary certification.

Phytosanitary Documentation

Domestic customers will be charged at actual cost for any needed quarantine compliance certificates. Foreign customers will be charged \$66.00 for each federal phytosanitary certificate, as well as the cost of any special testing or treatments required by destination country.
